

By order & direction from the Govern^r & Com^r for setting out land to the purchasers in Pensilvania & I hereby authorize thee to Survey and lay out to Tho Paschall four hundred & ninety acres contiguous to the lands thou Surveyed for William Smyth upon the Skoolkill River & let it be layd as conveniently and squarely as may be adjoyning to the Sayd Smiths land, because this land cant come to ye Sayd River, and to returne to me a true duplicate of the field worke & protracted figures which is to remaine in my office dated this 13th ^{mo} 1682
