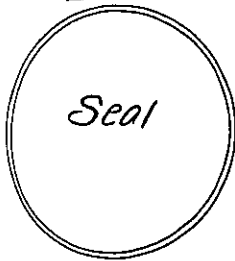


Pensylvania S.S.

At the Request of Reuben Pownel of the County of Bucks in behalf of his younger Brother George Pownel that we would grant him to take up the Proportion of Liberty Land appurtenant to their fathers Original Purchase of One thousand Acres, These are to Authorize thee to Survey and lay out to the Said George (to whom upon a partition of their fathers Estate the Right to the 5^d Liberty Land was allotted) the quantity of Sixteen acres of Land if so much is to be found Vacant within the Liberties of the City Philad^{la} beyond Skuy Kill and make returns into the Gen^l Surveyors Office at Philad^{la} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee Certified by the Secretary Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philad^{la} the 15th of November 1705 To David Powel Surveyor }
