the County of Bucks to survey to thee forthy proper use and behoof out of
a Vacant Tract in or near the Townships of Warminster and Southampton
in the Said County Six hundred and fifty Acres of Land in Right
and as part of Twelve hundred and fifty Acres by mee formerly granted
thee with the first purchaser and make returns therof into my
Secretarys Office - Given under my hand and Seale the nineteenth
day of April 1701.*
