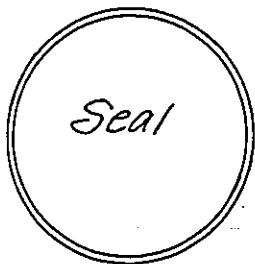

These are to authorize and require you to Survey and lay out or cause to be Surveyed & laid out for our Use the Quantity of Fifteen hundred Acres of Land on the North Side of Buffalo Creek beginning opposite the Mouth of a Small Run about four Miles below the Officers Survey on said Creek & extending downwards to include Barnys Cabin within about two Miles of the West Branch of the River Susquehanna and to make Return thereof into our Secretarys Office, And for so doing this shall be your Sufficient Warrant, Witness John Penn Esq^t Lieutenant Governor & Commissioner of Property of the said Province Who by virtue of certain powers from the said proprietaries hath hereunto set his Hand and caused the Seal of the Land Office to be affixed at Philadelphia this Seventeenth Day of March One thousand Seven hundred & Sixty nine
