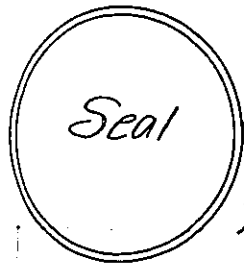


Pennsylvania S.S.



By the Proprietaries

These are to authorize and require you to Survey and lay out or cause to be surveyed & laid out Ten Thousand Acres of Land on the North East Branch of Susquehanna in one or more Tracts where the Land is good, from about five Miles below Wyalosing on either Side of the River as high up as Towandie Creek, and on the East Side of the Said River above that Creek as high up as Owegy, or on any of the Creeks within those Districts especially on Wyalosing & Sugar Creeks and to make <sup>return or Returns</sup> thereof into our Secretarys Office for our Use, And for so doing this shall be your Sufficient Warrant, Witness John Penn Esq<sup>r</sup> One of the said proprietaries who as well in his own Right as by virtue of certain powers from Thomas Penn Esq<sup>r</sup> the other proprietary hath hereunto set his Hand & caused the Seal of the Land Office to be affixed at Philadelphia this Twenty Seventh Day of September in the year of our Lord One thousand and Seven hundred & Seventy three
