



A Draught of a Tract of Land situate near Perkasio Mann<sup>r</sup> in the County of Bucks one part whereof contain<sup>g</sup> 300<sup>ac</sup> was surveyd to James Cooper on the 3<sup>d</sup> of May 1703 by Warr<sup>t</sup> from the Comm<sup>rs</sup> dated y<sup>e</sup> 18<sup>th</sup> of Feb. 1702<sup>r</sup> another part of 300 to John Marshal Surveyed y<sup>e</sup> 3<sup>d</sup> of May afores<sup>d</sup> by Warr<sup>t</sup> dated y<sup>e</sup> 18 of Feb. afores<sup>d</sup> the remain<sup>g</sup> part cont<sup>g</sup> 50<sup>ac</sup> to W<sup>m</sup> Briggs on the 27<sup>th</sup> of 10ber 1733<sup>rec.</sup> by Warr<sup>t</sup> from the Propr<sup>ts</sup> dated the 13<sup>th</sup> of the same Month and the s<sup>d</sup> Briggs having purchased Marshal's & Cooper's Tracts has sold to Henry Walmsley 200<sup>ac</sup> & to Martin Humble 150<sup>ac</sup> the remain<sup>g</sup> 300 was Return<sup>d</sup> into the Secret<sup>ys</sup> Office on the 14<sup>th</sup> of Jan<sup>r</sup> 1735 in order to be Confirmed to the s<sup>d</sup> W<sup>m</sup> Briggs

 Martin Humble's 150<sup>ac</sup> Returned the 18<sup>th</sup> of 7ber 1736
