given in the Said Letter the Said Surveyor accordingly laid
out in one Tract called Hilltown in y^e said County which
Tract has from the time of the sd Survey been in the pos-
session of the sd John and his Heirs or assigns but hath
never yet been returned according to the established regu-
lation nor past the Offices For supplying w^{ch} defect
