out lands to the purchasers in Pennsylvania I hereby  
authorize thee to survey and lay out to Capt W<sup>m</sup> Crispin  
his son Sylas, the quantity of five hundred acres next  
Contiguous to Griffith Jones his lands upon Delaware river,  
observing the rule of twenty pole to the hundred acres by  
the said river side, And to returne unto me an exact Du-  
plicate of the field work & protracted figure which is to remain  
in my office. Dated this 7<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>mo</sup> 1682
