

By virtue of a warrant from the Govern^t bearing date the 29th of y^e 1st mo 1775th directed to me to survey & set out unto John Hazelgrove & John Bezor near Marcus Hook towards y^e township late layd out calld Concord, one thousand acres to be equally & by lots divided among them both, and y^t they are willing to let y^e road from Marcus Hook, to Concord run through the sd thousand acres of Land where, by understanding men, it may be judged to be most convenient to travel, & fitt for horse & Cart carriage, I hereby authorize thee to survey & set out the sd number of acres unto them accordingly, where not already taken up & according to the method-obliterated- & make me a returne of the origir-obl-field work & protracted figure, w^{ch} by my patent-obl-to remain in my office, Philadelphia y^e 4th of y^e 2^d mo 1683.
