 is concealed nor seated by the Indians to be held under the
 Yearly Quittrent of a half penny Sterl^d p^r acre and make Re-
 turn into the General Surveyors Office at Philad^{ia}, where this
 Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv^d to thee
 certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands
 and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 10th
 day of the 5th Moth 1704
