By Vertue of a Warr<sup>t</sup> from y<sup>e</sup> Prop<sup>r</sup>y ~~and Certificate~~ dated the 19<sup>th</sup> day of the second Month 1684 directed to the Surv<sup>t</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup> I do by authority from him Certifie into the secretaries office That there was Surveyd and Laid out unto Lacey ~~and~~ Cock of Paksayunck in the County of Philadelphia the first day of the Eleav<sup>th</sup> Month 1693 a Certaine peice of swamp Marsh or Crippe in the Township of Paksayunck aforesaid Beginning at a Corn<sup>r</sup> Hickery Tree of — Moyer-sing Land from thence South throug<sup>h</sup> the said swamp & Crippe 320 perches To a Corner post standing by the River Delawa<sup>ver</sup> from Thence downe the sev<sup>l</sup> water Course<sup>s</sup> thereof to the Mouth of the River Skuilki<sup>ock</sup> from thence following up the severall water Courses up the River Schiulkill to the fast land of the afores<sup>d</sup> Township of the same, from thence following along the severall Courses of the s<sup>d</sup> fast Land & sev<sup>l</sup> Tracts of Meadow taken up adjoining to y<sup>e</sup> same to y<sup>e</sup> first Mentioned place of beginning Containeing Eight hundred seaventy five acres of the s<sup>d</sup> swamp Marsh & Crippe besides the sev<sup>l</sup> Tracts of Mowing Meadow Shittbrich Island, and a small peice of Rankers Hook, and is accordingly Entred in y<sup>e</sup> Surv<sup>t</sup> Gen<sup>l</sup>'s office the first day of the third M<sup>o</sup> 1694 =
