I do hereby Certifie that I have Examined the lines of the above Described tract of land and find them to be as follows Viz^t Begining at a post in the Swede^s tract thence ^{by Vac Land} N.W. ~~one~~ one hundred and Sixteen perches to a white oak thence by the lands of Ellis Hughes and Benjamin Boone South W^{est} two hundred seventy Eight to a post thence by the lands of the said Bobi-Boone and Squire Boone South East two hundred twenty two perches to a post in the said Swedes tract thence by the same two hundred ninety seven perches to the place of Begining Cont- two hundobl- ^{Seventy seven} ~~sixty eight~~ acres with the usual allowance of six pCent
