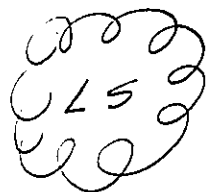


Pensylvania 55.

By the Commissioners of Property

At the request of Jacob Steager that we would grant him to take up one hundred and fifty Acres of Land on the West side of Schuylkill near that Tract which was seated by Peter Bizaillon and for some time possessed by Matthew Brooks for which he agrees to pay four and twenty pounds for the whole in one Year after the date hereof with Six Months Interest for the same and the Yearly Quit Rent of one shilling sterling p hundred for ever — These are to authorize and require thee to survey or cause to be surveyed to the said Jacob Steager according to the Method of Townships the said quantity of One hundred and fifty acres of Vacant Land in the place aforesaid and make return thereof into the Secretarys Office which survey in case the said Jacob fulfill the above agreement shall be valid otherwise the same to be void as if it had never been made nor this Warrant ever granted. Given under our hands & seal of the Province at Philad<sup>a</sup> the 15<sup>th</sup> day of the 12<sup>th</sup> Month A.D. 1717<sup>1/2</sup>
