



In Pursuance of a Warrant from the Trustees for the free Society of Traders dated y^e 25th of March 1724 I survey'd to David Lloyd Esq^r a Certain piece or p^{ce}l of Land Situate in Uwchlan in the County of Chester —

Beginning at a post at a Corner of other Land of the s^d David Lloyd thence by the same North west by North 105 pches to a post thence North East by Vacant Land 64 perches to a Spanish oak thence South 54^d East by the Land of the said David Lloyd 124 pches to post thence South west by west by the same Land 106 pches to the place of Beginning Containing fifty five acres and the proportionable part of the allowance of Six ^{acres} per Cent —
