One hundred and sixty five Acres, one hundred and fifty perches and allowance of six per Cent. Surveyed by William Matthews then D.S. on the 10th day of the 11th Month 1774. in pursuance of an Order from Richard Hockley granted to Philip Wagoner for 170^{acs} dated the 2nd April 1770 in order to agree for it. And now 16th March 1832. the same is examined, corrected and as the Official Work of the said William Matthews returned for confirmation.
