On Feb^ry 27th 1764 Christopher Whitman and Jacob Yeager leased of Mr Samuel Flower 25^{ac} of Land part of the Mine Tract near Reading which was patented to him for the Proprys Use. which 25^{ac} was to be surveyed and laid out upon Angelico Creek at the end of the said Tract. It has hitherto been own^d to be done. And therefore I request you order the Deputy of that district to do it immediatly, and mark it out by a straight line across the Tract and order him to return a Draught that it may be endorsed upon the back of each part of the Lease. He may dehi (obl.) ete^{it} upon the back of that in their possession. You please order him at the same time to lay out to John-Richards thirty Acres of the said mine Tract in a Square figure at a convenient part of the said Tract for which Richards is to have a Lease, and to return a Draught of that with the other.
