Where as by a Commission Under our hands and the Seal of the Province We have appointed thee Surveyor of the upper part of the County of Bucks in this Province. These therefore in pursuance of the sd Commission are to require thee to resurvey exactly and truly all the Lands and Tracts of Land in the Townships of Falls and Makefield within the Limits of thy said Commission according to the Several Divisions by which the said Lands were at first laid out or confirmed by Patent. Also to Survey and lay out all Such Tracts of Land in the sd County. and to execute such Warr<sup>ts</sup> for the Same as have been directed by the late Surveyor Gen<sup>l</sup> to Phineas Pemberton late Surveyor of the sd County that shall be again directed to thee by the Secretary. And make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philad<sup>ia</sup> where this Warr<sup>t</sup> is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delvd to thee certified by the Secretary. Given under our hands & ye Seal of ye Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 24<sup>th</sup> of ye 2<sup>d</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1702.
