But as I cannot agree with them before a proper Survey is made of the Premises. You are therefore desired forth with to Survey or cause to be Surveyed (at the Expence of the said Geo. and Christ^m Vogel) the 5^d Tract of 250 A.^s of Land and to furnish me with a Draught. Let it be certified by the Deputy Surveyor what Distance the 5^d Land is from the Town of York and of what Quality the Land is.
