

Pennsylvania ss.

By virtue of a warrant dated the 26 day of November 1748 I have caused to be surveyed on the 29th day of October 1749 to the use of the Honourable the Proprietaries a certain tract of land situate on Kind Creek beyond the Blue Mountains in the County of Lancaster. Beginning at a stone and from thence extending by vacant land the six courses and distances next following viz^t North twenty degrees east four hundred and twelve perches, north seventy degrees west Four hundred and eighty perches, south one hundred and thirty five Perches, south fifteen degrees west one hundred and seventy perches, south eleven degrees west sixty eight perches, and south sixty five degrees fifteen minutes east four hundred and eight perches to the place of Beginning Containing one thousand acres and the usual allowance of six acres & Cert for roads &c^e Returned into the Secretarys office the second day of January Anno Domini 1755.
now Berks County.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this eightth day of April 1910.
