

Whereas upon the Application of John Wright and Samuel Blunston and some others, Inhabitants of Pennsylvania, the Commissioners of Property did in the year 1728 order the said Samuel Blunston to lay out a tract of land of Twelve hundred acres lying on the West side of Susquehanna River, opposite to Hempfield, which land was divided into four several lots or Parcels, One of which, now in the Possession of the said Samuel Blunston, beginneth at the Mouth of a Creek running into the said River, commonly called Grist's Creek; thence up the said Creek one hundred & ten perches; thence south 68 degrees west one hundred & six perches; thence south 75 degrees west sixty perches, thence north 79 degrees West eighty eight perches to a marked Tree; thence south 62 degrees west one hundred & twenty perches; thence south 83 degrees west one hundred & ten perches to a marked corner black oak; thence north 10 degrees west one hundred & twenty eight perches to another marked corner Tree; thence by the lot or Parcel laid out to John Wright north 80 degrees east Five hundred & twenty six perches to the aforesaid River and along the several Courses of the River one hundred & twelve perches to the Place of Beginning, Containing three hundred & fifty acres of land as by the Draught of the said survey may be seen. And it appearing to me that the said Samuel Blunston is possessed of the said land by a regular survey made in the year 1728 of which I approve & will order a patent to be drawn for the same, as soon as the Indian Claim thereon shall be satisfied, on the like Terms that other lands in the County of Lancaster shall be granted.
