These are to authorize and require you to survey or cause to be surveyed for our use, Five thousand acres, round and near Shippensburg, between the South Mountains and Gonedogwainet Creek in Hopewell and adjacent Townships in the County of Cumberland, and make return thereof into our Secretary's office, and for your so doing this shall be your sufficient Warrant. Given under my Hand and the seal of the Land Office by virtue of certain powers from the said Proprietaries, at Philadelphia this ninth day of August in year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and sixty two.
