In purs: whereof the sd vacant Marshes were surveyd & divided accord<sup>g</sup> on the 2<sup>d</sup> day of May 1717 And the right to a certain part thereof hereafter described is now vested in And: Hamilton of the City of Philad<sup>a</sup> Esq<sup>r</sup> Beginning at & o
