

October the 16<sup>th</sup> day Anno 1718 Surveyd for Glemt Plumstead and George Fitzwater a certain parcel of Swamp or Creeple land near Myormensing in the County of Philadelphia by them bought of Abel Noble Beginning at a Black Oak by Hollanders Creek Thence West south west seven perches and three quarters of a perch to a small Maple tree by the side of the Crippe Then between the said Crippe and a Marsh or Meadow called the Sweads Meadow South by West four perches south eighteen degrees <sup>five</sup> East six perches south <sup>five</sup> Degrees east seven perches South sixty degrees west four perches South twenty degrees west two perches and a half South fifteen degrees east ten perches south forty west three perches South by west eleven perches south eighty <sup>degrs</sup> east four perches south sixty degrees east six perches South fourteen degrees west thirteen perches south twenty five degrees east through the Creeple <sup>23p</sup> to a Beech tree Then west by the Old line of the said Abel Nobles land thirty six perches to a corner post Then north by the said Nobles land sixty two perches to ~~an~~ Spanish Oak on the West side of Middle Creek Then north by east (crossing the said Creek) twelve perches to a Hickry Tree on the east of the said Creek <sup>then</sup> on the Several Courses of the same Seventy six perches to Hollanders <sup>Creek</sup> at the Mouth of the said Middle Creek Then south thirty <sup>degrs</sup> east over a small Neck or Point of Marsh twelve perch to the said Hollander Creek Then by the water courses of the same twenty nine perches to the place of Beginning Containing twenty acres.

IN TESTIMONY that the above is a copy of the original remaining on file in the Department of Internal Affairs of Pennsylvania, made conformably to an Act of Assembly approved the 16th day of February, 1833, I have hereunto set my Hand and caused the Seal of said Department to be affixed at Harrisburg, this second day of November 1910.
