

*Regulation of the Gutter at A Hamilton Jun<sup>r</sup> house*

*The Bottom of the Gutter in Water Street is 4 ft. 8<sup>in</sup> below a mark on a stone at a corner of Dickinson's house marked by J<sup>r</sup> Bringhamst  
thence an Asc<sup>t</sup> southw<sup>d</sup> of 2<sup>in</sup> in 10 ft.*

*On front St<sup>t</sup> southw<sup>d</sup> a Desc<sup>t</sup> of 3 in 10 ft w<sup>ch</sup> will be a foot above the top of a stake in a heap of stones*
