

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property bearing Date the 13th day of the 2^d month 1703 There was Surveyd and laid out unto ~~John~~ Jonathann Hayes of Chester County a Tract of land in Hatfield Township in the County ^{of} Philadelphia in Lieu of a Tract of Eleven Hundred acres bought by the said Jonathann of Benjamm Chamberlens formerly Illegally laid out in the Manor of Williamstadt The said Tract of land as now laid out Beginning at a post in a Line of the Proprietaries land and running by the land of Benjamm ffurlow Northwest ffour hundred and twenty one perches to a Corner post Then by Vacant ~~land~~ Land North east four hundred and sixty perches to a Corner tree Then South east by the line of John Morris's land four hundred and twenty one perches to a Corner tree Thence south west by the Proprietaries Land four hundred and sixty perches to the place of the Beginning Containing twelve hundred and ten acres
