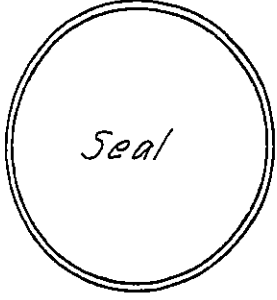


Pensylvania ss*By the Commissioners of Property*

*At the Request of William Hudson of Philad^a That we would Grant him a certain Lott on
 y^e South side of Mulberry Street lying amongst his other purchased Lotts & containing about
 forty nine foot and a half in breadth, for which he has agreed to pay forthwith upon Survey
 Seven pounds ten shillings to the Proprietor's Use, and one Shilling yearly for a Quit^t for
 ever hereafter. These are to Authorize thee to Survey or cause to be survey'd to the said
 William Hudson the said Vacant Lott of Ground and Return the same into the Secretaries
 Office Given under our hands and the seal of the Office at Philadelphia the 28th day
 of October A D 1713.*
