At the Request of Joshua Hart and Alice his Wife of Tomcester in the County of Northampton in Great Britain (the said Alice being only Daughter and Heires of John King late of Hadbury in y^e County of Bucks in Great Britain aforesaid Deceased) by their Attorney Richard Robinson of Philadelphia, That We would Grant them to take up the City Lotts and Liberty Land belonging to the Original Purchase of one Thousand Acres of Land made of the Prop^r by the said John King to be laid out in this Province which Lotts & Liberty Land fall on Schoolkill side of the said City These are to Authorize and Require thee to Survey or cause to be Surveyd & laid out unto the said Joshua Hart & Alice his Wife in Right of the said purchase the said Lotts of Ground within the said City and the Liberty Land with the Liberties thereof in proportion to the said Purchase and make Exact Returns of the whole into the Secretarys Office in Order for a further Confirmation Given under our hands and Seal of the Province at Philadelphia y^e 10th day of the 4th Month Anno Dⁿⁱ 1717
