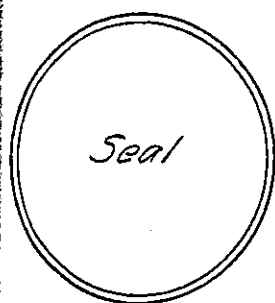

of the Province of Pensilvania & Countys annexed.*

*At the Request of Philip Howe I That I would grant him to take up twenty Acres of
Land within the Liberties of the City of Philadelphia in right of Henry Pawlin's first
Purchase of one Thousand Acres of Land: These are to require thee forthwith to Survey
or cause to be survey'd to the s^d Henry Pawlin the s^d Number of twenty Acres within
the s^d Liberties of Philadelphia and make Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office.
Given under my hand and Seal at Philadelphia the 26th day of the Second Month
