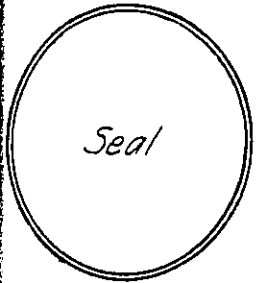


Pennsylvania ss*By the Commission^{rs} of Property*

*At the Request of William Biles in behalf of Thomas Hudson That we would grant
 him a Resurvey on the City Lots appurtenant to the Original Purchase of Isaac Gellins
 of five thousand Acres and of John Cole of One thousand Acres These are to Authorize
 and Require thee to Resurvey to the s^d Thomas Hudson (now possess^r of the Right to the said
 Lots) all the City Lots belonging to the s^d Purchase as they originally fell on the River
 Skuylkill and make Returns into the General Surveyor's Office at Philadelphia where this
 Warrant is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv^d to thee certified by the Secretary.
 Given under our hands and the Seal of the Province at Philad^{ia} the 27th of y^e 4th Moth 1704
