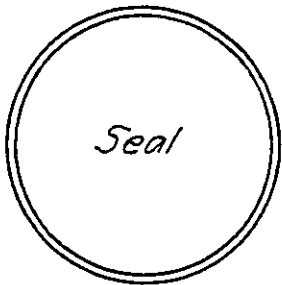


*William Penn Proprietary & Govern<sup>r</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> Province of Pennsilvania,

according to y<sup>e</sup> method of Townships appointed by me, & make returns thereof  
into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 24<sup>th</sup> <sup>Mo</sup>/<sub>15<sup>th</sup></sub> 1683*
