These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey the s^d two hundred and fifty Acres distinct and therewith the whole Tract of five hundred Acres by Lines the least Injurious to the said Mann^e and also to the Tenants Inhabiting thereon, and make Returns into the General Surveyor's Office at Philad^{ia} where this Warr^t is to remain and a Copy thereof to be delivered to thee certified by the Secretary.
