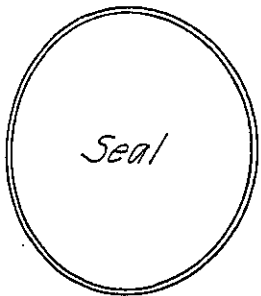

*At the Request of Philip Howe! That I would grantt him a Resurvey on two Lotts on
the Bank of Delaware of twenty five foot each, one of them granted by my Comm^{rs}
of Property to the s^d Philip and the other to William Bradford, of whom the s^d Philip
since bought the same and are now both in his possession bounded Northw^d wth the
Lott of George Heathcott Eastw^d wth y^e River Delaware Southward wth Darby Greets Lott
& Westw^d wth the front Street, These are to require three forthwth to Resurvey or cause to be
Resurvey'd ^{the s^d Lotts} according to the s^d Dimensions of 50 foot and the s^d Northw^d Westward and
Southward Bounds thereof, of w^{ch} make returns into my Secretaries Office. Given under
my hand and Seal at Philad^{ia} the 29th of y^e first Month 1701.*
