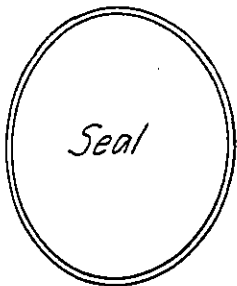

*William Penn Absolute Proprietor & Governour in Chief
of the Province of Pennsylvania & Countys Annexed.*

*At the Request of John Hart That I would grant him a Resurvey on a Tract of Land
Situate in Biberry Township in the County of Philadelphia, laid out by my Ord^r for
four hundred and forty Acres adjoining to Lacy Boores or the Land that was formerly
accounted his: These are to require thee forthwith to Resurvey or cause to be resurvey'd the
said Tract of Land according to the first Lines and Bound's of Survey, and make
to Subdivide if same as he shall direct
Returns thereof into my Secretaries Office. Given under my hand and Seal at
Philadelphia the nineteenth day of the Third Month 1701.*
