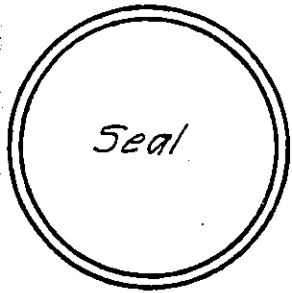


Pennsylvania ss.*Seal**By the Commissioners of Property*

At the Request of John Harris that We would Grant him to take up the Lot of Ground in the City of Philadelphia and the Proportion of Liberty Land in the City Liberties Appurtenant to the Original Purchase of five Hundred Acres of Land made of the Late Proprietor by Roger Beck the Right whereof being now Vested in the said John Harris as set forth by his Attorney Isaac Taylor. These are to Authorize thee to Survey & lay out or cause to be Survey'd and laid out unto the said John Harris within the said City the said Lot of Ground where the same fell by allotment if Vacant, and the proportion of Liberty Land within the said Liberties where it may be found untaken up and make Returns thereof into the Secretarys Office in Order for a further Confirmation Given under our Hands and the Lesser Seal of the Province at Philadelphia the first day of the first Month Anno Dni 172⁹/₆
