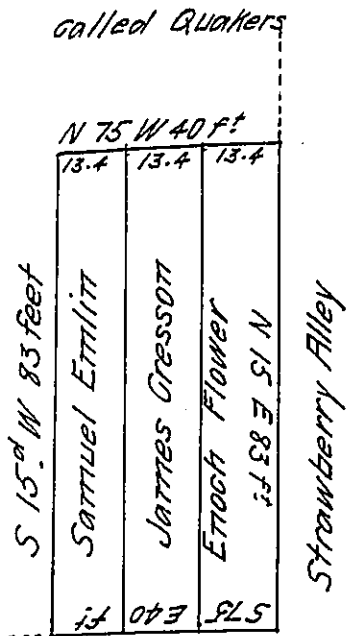


Ground belonging to the Society on W. 4th Street Meeting house stands

In pursuance of a Warrant from the Proprietaries dated the 9th of March 1740 Surveyed for their use the same day the above described Lot of Ground in Philad^a City on the South side of High Street between the 2^d & 3^d lots from Delaware Bank & Returned into the Secretary's Office the day afores^d. The Proprietary T.P. soon after obl this Lot to Sam^l Ettillitt Enoch Flower & James Gresson (for 600 £ Currency & 1 obl. ft. Quit Rent i.e. £ 2 sterl^g P. Ann^y) who divide the same into three obl
