By vertue of a war^t ffrom y^e LeⁱU^t Govern^r &c dated y^e 19th of Aug^r 1693 directed to y^e Survey^r General I do by Authority ffrom him Certifie that there was Survey^d and Laid out y^e same day unto Phil England ffor y^e use of y^e ferry Elavert acres of Land adjoining to the said ferry on y^e Schuylkill which is bounded to y^e North Eastward wth a small Runn and vacant Land, and to y^e Northwestward with y^e River Schuylkill to y^e South westward with Wth Bowings Lot and to y^e South Eastward with Schuylkill ffront Street which is accordingly Entered and Recorded in y^e Sury^r General! office at Philad^a y^e 28th of Aug^r 1693
