



By Vertue of a warrant to Roland Ellis bearing date — and by an order from him surveyd this tract of Land begining at a black oak standing in Buskirks Line and then North East one hundred and nine perch by the said Buskirks Land to a black oak then South East one hundred and fifty six perches by vacant Land to a small hickry then south west one hundred and nine perch by John Humphreys Land then north west one hundred fifty six perch to the place of begining Containring one hundred and six acres of Land on the Edg of a poor stoney hill near Parksey in Bucks County surveyd the twenty second of the ninth month 1725 surveyd to William Thomas by me
