



Pursuant to an Order from Jacob Taylor to me directed bearing date the 12 day of June ann^o 1725 to Survey unto Gorge Phillips the quantity of 250 acres of Land in the County of Bucks being part of 3000 acres Latly purched by Rowland Ellis Thes may sartyfie that I have Surveyd the sam in the Great Swamp Beginning at a whit oak being the Corner of Thomas Roberts Land and then North one hundred and forty pearches to a Post then East two hundred and thirty pearches by Vacant Land to a whit oak then South one hundred and Eighty ~~four~~ pearches to a Poplar by Vacant Land then West two hundred forty and Six Pearches by Vacant Land to a Spanish Oak then North Nor east forty Pearch by the said Roberts Land to the place of begining containing two hundred and Sixty five acres fiftene of it is allowed for Road and highways Surveyd the nineteenth day of the fourth Month 1725 by me -
