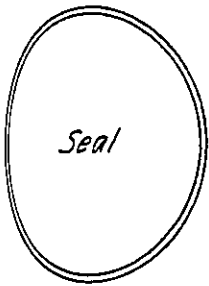

At the Request of Rowland Ellis That We would Grant him a Resurvey on two certain parcels of Land within the Welch Tract the one laid out for five hundred Acres in Mejrion and the other for four hundred and Eighty three Acres in Goshen, both by vertue of a Genl Warr<sup>t</sup> from the Prop<sup>ty</sup> for laying out & subdividing the s<sup>d</sup> Tract ~~and~~ bearing date the 13<sup>th</sup> of the first Month 1684 and in right of y<sup>e</sup> s<sup>d</sup> Rowlands Purchase under Richard Davies These are to require thee forthwith to resurvey to the s<sup>d</sup> Rowland Ellis the s<sup>d</sup> five hundred Acres of Land in Mejrion and the s<sup>d</sup> four hundred and eighty three Acres in Goshen laid out as afores<sup>d</sup> and make Returns thereof into the Genl Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warr<sup>t</sup> is to remain and a Copy thereof to be deliv<sup>d</sup> to thee Attested by the Secretary who is also to take a Duplicate of thy Return into his Office. Given under our hands & y<sup>e</sup> Seal of the Province at Philad<sup>ia</sup> the 11<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> 12<sup>th</sup> Mo<sup>th</sup> 1701.
