



By Virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietor dated the 28 day of May 1733 and by an order from Jacob Taylor to me directed I have Surveyed this Tract of Land to Adam Marker for an old Right which he bought Beginning at a Whit Oak marked for a corner standing in the Line of Richard Hills Land then North west two hundred and twelve Pearches to a Post by the said Hills Land then South west two Hundred Ninty Eight Pearches by Marpols Land and other Lands to a Post then South East two hundred and twelve Pearches by Jettken William^{rs} Land to a small Hickory then North East two hundred and Ninty Eight Pearches by vacant Land to the place of beginning Containing three Hundred Seventy five acres with usual allowance for Roads Surveyed in the County of Bucks near Hill Township the 20 of the 4 month 1733
