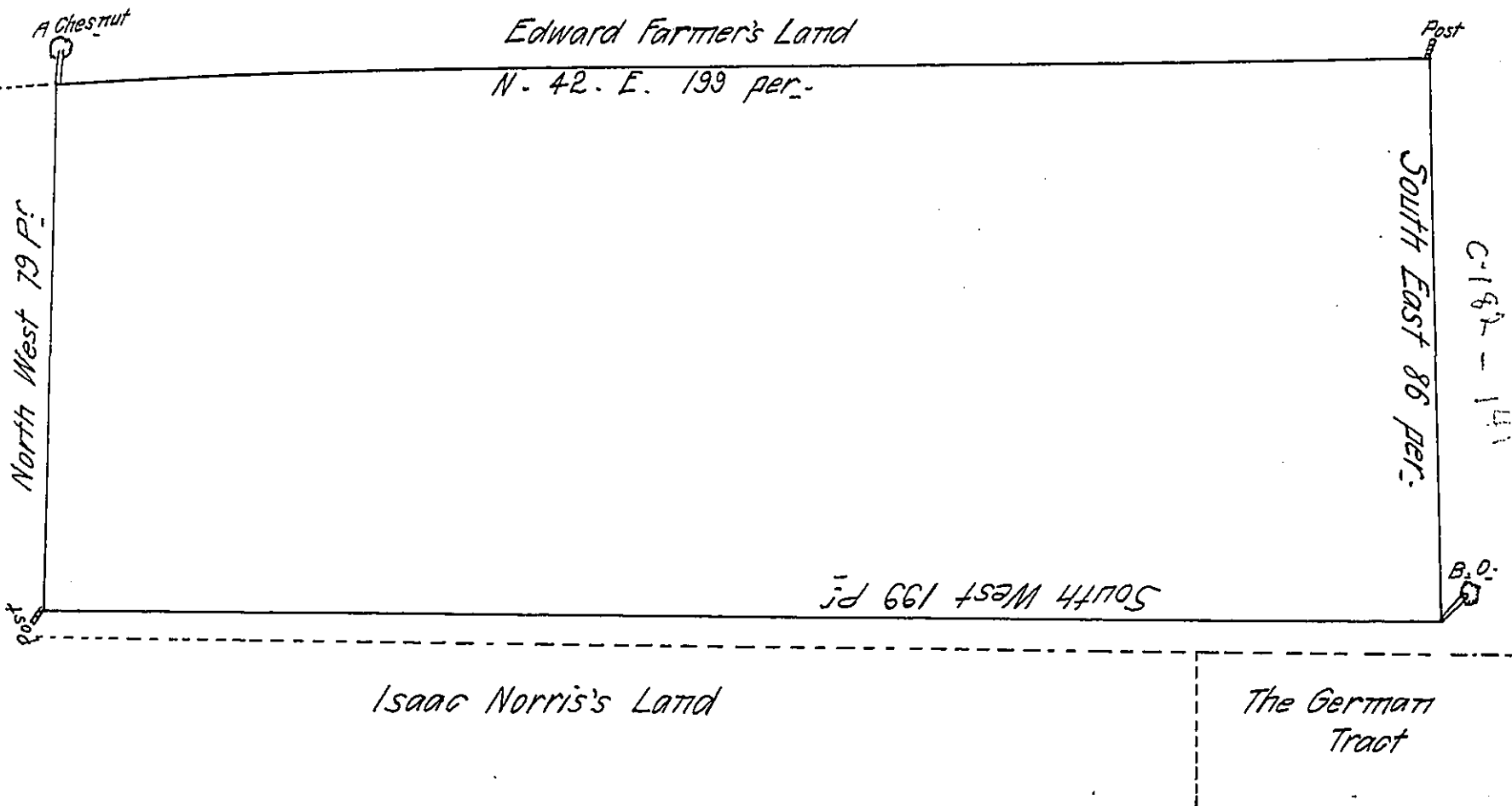

By Virtue of a Warrant from the Commissioners of Property Dated the fifth Day of December Anno Domini 1727 Requiring me to Survey unto Arent Hassert one hundred Acres of Land in the Mannor of Springfield in Right of the Like Quantity formerly Granted to John Henry Sprugel there was Survey'd on The Twentieth Day of March 1727/8 for the said Arent Hassert a Tract of Land in the said Mannor beginning at a Black Oak four perches North West from the Line of Germantown Tract thence runing Southwest parallel to the said Line and the Line of Isaac Norris Land one hundred Ninty Nite Perches to a Post Thence North West Seventy Nite Perches to a Chestnut Tree in the Line of Edward Farmers Land then by the same North forty Two Degrees East one hundred Ninty Nite Perches to a Post then South East Eighty Six perches to the Place of Beginning Containing one hundred and Two Acres and a half
