

By Vertue of a Warrant under the hands of the Commissioners<sup>s</sup> of property  
and the seal of the Province dated the 29<sup>th</sup> day of the seventh  
month 1702 for Resurveying of Gwynedd.

Resurvey'd unto Edward ap Hughes a Tract of land in Gwynedd in the County  
of Philadelphia beginning at a White oak at the Corner of Evan ap Hughes  
land from thence extending ~~by the said land~~ south east one hundred  
seventy six perches to a stake at the Corner of Thomas Evans land thence  
by a line of Marked trees and the south forty six degrees and a half ~~east~~  
west two hundred twenty three perches and a half to stake at the Corner  
of Robert Jones his land from thence by the s<sup>d</sup> land North thirty five degrees  
west one hundred seventy six perches to a stake in the said ap Hughes  
line
