ordered to be located adjoining on the land of ^{George} ~~Richard~~ Collet near
Indian ^{Creek} ~~River~~ w^{ch} Land adjoining as aforesaid I had several months
since granted to Hugh Rob^{ts} in right of Rich^d Thomas purchaser of
5000 acres To the end therefore that none may reap the profit of the
s^d fraudulent proceeding to the manifest injury and wrong of another
I doe hereby strictly charge and require thee that thou forthwith
putt a stop to the execution of the s^d warr^t and so much thereof
as located the s^d 80 acres being wholly and absolutely contrary to my intention is
hereby declared void to all intents & purposes as if it had never been therein expres^t. The rest of
y^e s^d warr^t to stand valid and good. Given under my hand, and seal at Philad^{ia} The first day of y^e 12th moth 170⁹.
