 for that he is very unwilling to accept of less than y<sup>e</sup> 100<sup>a</sup>.

WILLIAM PENN Proprietary & Govern<sup>r</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> Province of  
 Pennsylvania & y<sup>e</sup> Territories therunto belonging.

At y<sup>e</sup> Request of Dennis Rochford y<sup>t</sup> I would grant him to  
 take up his proportions of land w<sup>th</sup>in y<sup>e</sup> Liberties of y<sup>e</sup> City.

These are to will & require thee forthw<sup>th</sup> to survey or cause to be  
 survey'd unto him One hundred acres of land on the <sup>side</sup> Skulkill<sup>n</sup>  
 journeying to his settlem<sup>t</sup> he at present liveth upon, and make returns  
 thereof into my Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia y<sup>e</sup> 20<sup>th</sup>  
 of y<sup>e</sup> 10<sup>th</sup> mo 1683.
