



In pursuance of a warrant granted to John Simpson of London, dated the 31st day of the tenth mo 1733. for taking up the Liberty land appurtenant to the original purchase of 10,000 acres in this province made by William, Margaret, John, and Ann Charlott Lowther there was surveyed on the 15th day of April 1776, ^{it having been surveyed for the Hon^{ble} proprie-} the above described tract of ^{aries in 1736 by B.E.} twelve acres and a half of land situate on the west side of Schuylkill in the Township of Blockley for William Allen Esquire, who purchased of said John Simpson and informed me he had agreed to convey the same to William Hamilton, Esquire
