

By virtue of a Warrant from the Proprietary dated y<sup>e</sup> 21<sup>st</sup> of the  
<sup>1710</sup>  
 8<sup>th</sup> 1701 for laying out unto Andreas Rudman ten thousand acres  
 of land for the use of himself and several of the Swedes.

Survey'd and laid out the 28<sup>th</sup> of y<sup>e</sup> <sup>1710</sup>5<sup>th</sup> 1704 unto Richard  
 Roads five hundred acres of land (part of of the said ten thousand  
 acres) Scituate on the east side of Schuylkil—in the County of  
 Philad<sup>ia</sup> Beginning at a post by Schuylkil-River at the corner  
 of Matthias Netcelion's land then by the same north twenty deg<sup>s</sup>  
 east one thousand two hundred and seventy perches to a post  
 then by vacant land south south east sixty two perch<sup>s</sup> to a  
 post then by the line of Mounse Justice's land south 20 deg<sup>s</sup>  
 west one thousand and three hundred perches to a post by  
 Schuylkil—then up the same to the Beginning. by D. Powel—
