At ye Request of John Taylor on behalf of Thomas Callowhill Purchaser of Five thousand five hundred Acres yt we would grant him to take up his Lotts & Land wthin ye Liberties proportionable to his purchase. These are in ye Proprietary's name to will & require thee forthwth to survey or cause to be surreyed unto him ye sd Lotts where they fell & land wthin ye Liberties, he fencing & building on ye front & fencing & clearing ye Lott in ye High Street wthin Six months from ye date of Survey & make returns thereof into ye Secretary's Office. Given at Philadelphia ye 10th 12th mo 1684.
