These are to require thee forthwith to survey or cause to be
survey'd unto my son William Penn ten thousand Acres of land the
remainder due to him of fifty thousand acres originally granted by
me to his Mother in one or more convenient Tracts in any County
or Counties of this Province and make returns thereof into my
Secretaries Office. Given under my hand and seal at Philad^{ia}
the 15th day of the 7th Moth 1701.
