These are to authorize and Require you or one of you exactly to resurvey the said Tract of Land according to the lines of the located lands bounding upon it and the said River with attested Chaincarriers and make Returns into the General Surveyors Office at Philadelphia where this Warr^t is to remain and Copies thereof to be delvd to you certified by the Secretary Given under our hands and the seal of the Province at Philadelphia the second day of the third Month 1704.
