

Pursuant to a warrant under the hand and seal of the proprietary and Gov^r bearing date the 26th day of the 3^d month 1701 ordering a thousand acres of land to be surveyd and laid out de novo unto Gunner Rambo and Peter Cocks in the place where they are seated in the Proprietari^es Daughter's Mannor

There is resurveyd unto Gunner Rambo a tract of land on the west side of Schuylkill within the bound of Latitia Penn's Mannor beginning at a white oak at the corner of Peter Cocks land from thence by the said Cocks land east nor-east seven hundred and twelve perches to a hickory tree by Skuylkil from thence by the several courses of the same the several distances on the said courses added together two hundred thirty-eight perches to a second hickory by the said Skuylkil River from thence by the Widow Yocum's Land and by Jn^o. Hugh's land west south west five hundred forty-four perches to a black oak from thence north north-west by the Mannor land one hund^d and fifty perches to the place of the beginning Containing six hundred and fourteen acres Resurveyd by David Powel the 10th mo 1702.
